Article 1: A competitive entrance examination for admission of 205 students into the First year of the Mineral Prospecting and Exploration Technologies, Mining Engineering, and Petroleum and Gas Engineering Programmes of the School of Geology and Mining Engineering of the University of Ngaoundere, for 2017/2018 academic year.

<u>Article 2</u>: (1) The entrance examination is open to Cameroonians of both sexes who are holders of the "Baccalauréat" (series C, D, E or F1), the General Certificate of Education Advanced Level (GCE "A" Level) in at least three science subjects, and the GCE "O" Level, or any other equivalent certificate recognized by the Ministry of Higher Education. "Religious Knowledge" is not taken into consideration.

Candidates from Central African Economic and Monetary Union (CEMAC) member countries where texts on national treatment of students have been ratified and who are

holders of required qualifications are eligible to write the entrance examination under the same conditions as their Cameroonian counterparts.

(2) Candidates from other countries including CEMAC member countries who do not write the entrance examination but hold a scholarship from their government or an International Organization may apply for direct admission, which is contingent upon the number of available places and payment of tuition fees according to their status.

## Article 3: The application file must include the following documents:

1. A hand written application bearing a 1000 CFA francs stamp;

- The receipt of payment of the sum of 20,000 CFA francs. This sum should be paid into the School of Geology and Mining Engineering bank account n° 10029 26017 01215583101-24 ECOBANK-CAMEROON Ngaoundere;
- 3. A certified true photocopy of the GCE "A" Level Certificate, "Baccalauréat" (science series) or an equivalent certificate; or a certified copy of results slip;
- 4. A Certificate of Non Conviction (bulletin n°3) (issued not more than 03 months earlier);
- 5. A certified true photocopy of Birth Certificate (issued not more than 03 months earlier):
  - 6. A medical certificate signed by a Government Medical Practitioner;
  - 7. 04 passport size photographs (4 x 4);
- 8. A large (A4-size) envelope with a 500 CFA francs stamp bearing candidate's address.

<u>Article 4</u>: A press release from the Rector of the University of Ngaoundéré will specify as need be, for each examination centre, the venue and the planning of the conduct of the examination papers.

<u>Article 5</u>: The written phase of the Competitive Entrance Examination includes the following subjects for all specialties:

<u>Article 6</u>: Candidates are invited to present themselves in front of the examination rooms one hour before the start of the first subject, with their National Identity Card and their submission of file receipt.

<u>Article 7</u>: The examination syllabuses are those used in classes preparing for the "Baccalauréat" C, D, E and F1 or GCE "A" level in **Mathematics**, **Physics and Chemistry**.

<u>Article 8</u>: Each candidate should deposit, **not later than 1**<sup>st</sup> **September 2017**, a complete application file comprising the following documents:

- MINESUP (Department of University Accreditations and Quality);
- The ten (10) Regional Delegations of the Ministry of Secondary Education;
- The Secretariat of the Rector of the University of Ngaoundere;
- The Students' Records Service of the School of Geology and Mining Engineering at Meiganga;
- The Nkolbisson Antenna of the University of Ngaoundere in Yaounde.

<u>Article 9</u>: Candidates admitted on file study are required to pay their university fees of an amount of one million CFA francs (1 000 000) CFA, in accordance with Decree n°93/033 of 19 January 1993, laying down provisions of Decree No. 79/186 of 17 May 1979 fixing the rate of payment of university fees.

<u>Article 10</u>: Following the publication of results, candidates who are finally admitted will have 15 days from the date of effective start of the courses to present themselves at the School in order to complete the registration formalities. After this deadline, those who have not presented themselves at the School will be considered as having abandoned and, if necessary, replaced by the candidates on the waiting list in order of merit, by decision of the Minister of Higher Education, on the proposal of the Rector of the University of Ngaoundere.

<u>Article 11</u>: The expenditure pertaining to the organization of the above mentioned Competitive Entrance Examination are incurred on the 2017 budget of the University of Ngaoundere.

<u>Article 12</u>: The Rector of the University of Ngaoundere, the Director of University Accreditations and Quality, and the Director of the School of Geology and Mining Engineering of the University of Ngaoundere, are each in their capacity, responsible for the implementation of this order which shall be registered and published in English and French wherever need be.
