To launch the competitive entrance examination into level I of the cycles of Veterinary Doctors and of Engineers in Animal Production and fixing the number of places for admission at the School of Veterinary Medicine and Sciences (SVMS) of the University of Ngaoundere for the 2024/2025 academic year.

Mindful of the Order n° 07/0176/MINESUP of October 30, 2007 opening the School of Veterinary Medicine and Sciences of the University of Ngaoundere;
Mindful of Order n° 18230069 /MINESUP/SG/DAUQ/SDEAC of 14 February 2024, setting dates for competitive entrance examinations for admission into Faculties and Schools of State Universities for the 2024/2025 academic year;

On the proposal of the Rector of the University of Ngaoundéré,

Announces:

Article 1: Two competitive entrance examinations by writing, is opened for the admission of **seventy (70)** students into Level I of the cycle of Veterinary Doctors and **fifty (50)** students into Level I of the cycle of engineers in Animal Production at the School of Veterinary Medicine and Sciences (SVMS) of the University of Ngaoundere for the 2024/2025 academic year. The competitive examinations will take place on **October 11th 2024** for the cycle of Engineers in Animal Production and, on **October 12th 2024** for the cycle of Veterinary Doctors in the following centres: **Ngaoundéré – Dschang – Maroua – Yaounde and Buea.**

Article 2: (1) The entrance examination is open to Cameroonians of both sexes of **twenty six (26) years** old as of December 31st 2024, who are holders of the Baccalauréat (serie C or D), the General Certificate of Education Advanced Level in at least three science subjects including Biology or any other equivalent certificate recognised by the Ministry of Higher Education.

(2) Citizens of member countries of the Central African Economic Union (CEMAC) which have ratified texts on national treatment of students and, who are holders of equivalent qualifications are eligible to write the entrance examination under the same conditions as their Cameroonian counterparts.

(3) Cameroonian candidates and those from other countries including CEMAC member countries may apply for direct admission which is contingent upon the number of available places (with a maximum of ten (10) places for the Veterinary Doctors and ten (10) places also for the Engineers in Animal Production), **but must:**

1°) **Be a beneficiary of a scholarship from their Government or International organisation that will cover the tuition fees;**

2°) **Be not more than twenty six (26) years old on December 31st 2024.**

Article 3: Each candidate should forward to the Students' Affairs and Records department of SVMS, not later than **October 10th 2024**, for the Engineers in Animal Productions and **October 11th 2024** for Veterinary Doctors, a complete application file comprising the following documents:

- An application form obtainable from the SVMS of the University of Ngaoundere, other ten State Universities (Inter-University Co-operation Service), Regional Delegations of Secondary Education, the University of Dschang's off-campus stations Maroua and the Ngaoundere university's antenna in Yaounde . It can also be obtained from the web site of the Ministry of Higher Education: **http: //www.minesup.gov.com** and **university of Ngaoundere; www.univ-ndere.com**
- A certified true photocopy of the GCE "A" Level certificate, "baccalauréat" (scientific series) or an equivalent certificate; or a certified copy of results slip ;
- Certified true photocopies of "baccalauréat" and "probatoire" transcripts or a certified photocopy of GCE "A" and "O" results ;
- A certified true photocopy of birth certificate (issued not more than 3 months earlier);
- A medical certificate signed by a Government Medical Practitioner ;
- 4 recent passport size photographs (4x4) ;
- A receipt upon payment of **FCFA twenty thousands (20.000)** as application fees. The application fees are paid either into the bank account N° **01207980601/11** in **ECOBANK**, or through, **Express Exchange** to **ESMV (University of Ngaoundéré)**.
- A large (A4 size) **self-addressed** stamped envelope (postage determined with the contents of file) with **full address of the candidate or parents**.

Article 4: The application fees are non – refundable.

Article 5: Only candidates who submit complete application files shall be authorised to write the entrance examination.

Article 6: (1) The entrance examination shall comprise a written part and an assessment of candidates' previous academic records.

(2) The written examination shall comprise the following papers:

General Knowledge	2 hours	2

(3) The examination syllabuses are the same as those used in the classes preparing for the required certificates that are, the GCE "A" Level and baccalauréat.

Article 7:

(1) Each paper shall be marked out of 20 points and a score below 04/20 in any of the papers shall eliminate the candidate.

(2) Assessment of candidates' previous academic records shall be based on the following:

- Baccalauréat and Probatoire transcripts (francophone candidates) ;
- General Certificate of Education "A" Level and "O" Level results ;
- The number of times the candidate repeated between "O" and "A" levels;
- The number of years after graduate the GCE "A" level.

Article 8:

(1) The final mark in the examination shall be calculated as follows: **80% for the written examination and 20% for the candidate's previous academic records.**

(2) The results shall be compiled and prepared by a jury appointed by the Minister of State, Minister of Higher Education.

Article 9: The Rector of the University of Ngaoundéré, the Director of the University Accreditations and Quality and the Director of the School of Veterinary Medicine and Sciences are each in his capacity, responsible for the implementation of this press release, which shall be registered and published in English and French, wherever need be.
