To launch the Competitive Entrance Examination into **first year** (Level I) of the Bachelor's cycle the Biomedical sciences of the Faculty of Medecine and Biomedical sciences (FMSB) of the University of Garoua for the 2023-2024 academic year title.

Mindful of Decision n° 18240028/MINESUP/SG/DAUQ/SDEAC of February 2024 organize the calendar of competitive entrance examinations into establishments of Cameroon state Universities and schools under the auspices of the Ministry of Higher Education for 2024-2025 academic year

**DECIDES AS FOLLOWS:**



**Article 1:** A written competitive examination for the recruitment for the recruitment of **fifty (50) students** in the **first year** of the Faculty of Medecine and Biomedical Sciences of the University of Garoua, is open for the 2024/2025 academic year. Candidates will sit for the examinations at the Garoua, Maroua, Ngaoundéré and Yaoundé centres. The competition date is set for **24/09/2024**.

The places available are distributed as follows:

**Article 2:** (1) The competition is open in a single session to Cameroonians of both sexes who hold a Baccalaureate series C, D, E, F8, TIC, a General Certificate of Education Advanced Level (GCE "A" Level) in at least three scientific subjects and a GCE "O" Level, or a diploma recognised as equivalent by the Minister of Higher Education. "Religious Knowledge" is not taken into account.

(2) Candidates who are nationals of member countries of the Economic and Monetary Community of Central Africa (CEMAC), which have ratified the texts relating to the national treatment of students, and who can prove that they have the required qualifications, will be admitted to sit the exam under the same conditions as their Cameroonian counterparts.

**Article 3:** Complete application files must reach the Schooling Department of the Faculty of Medicine and Biomedical Sciences of the University of Garoua no later than **20/09/2024 at 3:30 PM**.

- 1- A registration form available on the MINESUP website / in the regional delegations of secondary education in Adamawa, Centre, North and Far North and at the schooling service of the Faculty of Medicine and Biomedical Sciences of the University of Garoua.
- 2- A receipt of payment of the sum of 20,000 (twenty thousand) CFA Francs for the competition registration fee from Société Générale Cameroun (SGC) (account No **10003-00700-22071275110-74**)
- 3- A certified photocopy of the Baccalauréat, GCE A/L or a certified certificate of successful completion of one of these diplomas;
- 4- Certified photocopies of the Baccalauréat and Probatoire transcripts or a certified copy of the GCE A/Level and GCE O/Level diplomas;
- 5- Certified photocopies of birth certificates less than 03 (three) months old;
- 6- A medical certificate issued by a government doctor stating that the applicant is fit to pursue higher education;
- 7- Five 4x4 passport-size photographs (write the name on the back);
- 8- An envelope (A4 format) stamped by the post office (with the weight of the enclosures and the applicant's address).

**Article 4:** Only candidates submitting a complete application will be allowed to compete.

**Article 5:** (1) The competition consists of two parts:

- A study of the candidate's academic record (coefficient 2, that is. 30% of the final mark),
- Written tests (coefficient 5, that is. 70% of the final mark).

(2) The study of the academic record (coefficient 2) is based on:

- The results of the Probatoire or GCE "O" Level;
- The results of the Baccalaureate or GCE "A" Level;
- The number of repeats.

(3) The written tests are as follows:

- A **Biology** test consisting of multiple-choice questions lasting one hour and with a coefficient of 2;
- A **Chemistry** test consisting of multiple-choice questions lasting one hour and with a coefficient of 1;
- A **Physics** test consisting of multiple-choice questions lasting one hour with a coefficient of 1;
- A **General Knowledge** test consisting of one-hour multiple-choice questions on current affairs, with a coefficient of 1.

**Article 6:** Each paper in the written examination is marked from zero to one hundred (0 to 100). Any mark of less than twenty obtained in any of the written tests is eliminatory.

**Article 7:** The competition syllabus is that of the Baccalaureate Cor D, or the GCE "A" Level in the subjects: Biology, Chemistry and Physics.

**Article 8:** The Rector of the University of Garoua, the Director of University Accreditations and Quality and the Dean of the Faculty of Medicine and Biomedical Sciences of the University of Garoua shall be responsible, each in his own area of responsibility, for the execution of this Decision, which shall be registered and communicated wherever necessary.
