To launch the competitive examinations into the 1st year of the first cycle and into the 1st year of the second cycle of the Advanced Teacher Training College for Technical Education of the University of Douala, for the 2022/2023 academic year.

THE MINISTER OF STATE, MINISTER OF HIGHER EDUCATION,

- Mindful of law n° 005 of 16 April 2001 to lay down the orientation of Higher Education ;
- Mindful of decree n° 2004/320 of the 8th December 2004 organizing the Government modified and completed by decree n° 2007/268 of the 7th September 2007;
- Mindful of decree n° 2004/322 of the 8th December 2004 organizing the Government modified and completed by decree n° 2015/434 of 02 October 2015 reorganizing the Government;
- Mindful of decree n° 2005/142 of 29 April 2005 organizing the Ministry of Higher Education ;
- Mindful of decree n° 93/026 of 19 January 1993 to create Universities;
- Mindful of decree n° 93/027 of 19 January 1993 concerning common dispositions to Universities modified and completed by decree n° 2005/342 of 10 September 2005;
- Mindful of decree n° 93/033 of the 19th January 1993 modifying some dispositions of decree n° 79/186 of the 17th May 1979 fixing the rate of university fees ;
- Mindful of decree n° 2005/383 of 17 October 2005 fixing financial regulations applicable to universities;
- Mindful of decree n° 93/030 of 29 January 1993 to lay down administrative and academic organization of the University of Douala;
- Mindful of decree n° 541/CAB/PR of the 28 September 1990 to lay down reorganization of the Advanced Teacher's Training College for Technical Education, University of Douala;
- Mindful of decision n° 041/MESIRES of September 1991 to lay down conditions for admission into the Higher Teacher Training College for Technical Education of the Douala University Centre;
- Mindful of decision n° 18220053/MINESUP/GS/DUAQ/SDEAC/SE of the 16th March 2022 fixing the calendar of the competitive examinations into the Cameroon State Universities for the 2022-2023 academic year;
- Mindful of circular n° 004/CAB/PM of 10 February 2000 concerning the admission in National Advanced Training institutions and recruitments in the Public Service;
- Mindful of fax-message n° 22-00256/MINESUP/GS/DAUQ/na of the 2nd August 2022 modifying the number of places for the admission into the existing departments offered in the Advanced Teacher's Training College for Technical Education, University of Douala;

On the proposition of the Rector of the University of Douala ;

ORDERS

ARTICLE 1:

- 1) In accordance with decision n° 18220053/MINESUP/GS/DUAQ/SDEAC/SE of the 16th March 2022 to fix the calendar of competitive entrance examinations for 2022/2023 academic year, the competitive entrance examinations into ENSET for the 2022/2023 academic year are launched with conditions stipulated in the present order.
- 2) **EXAMINATION CENTRES:** The written part of the examinations specified above shall take place in the following centres: **BAFOUSSAM, DOUALA, GAROUA and YAOUNDE** for entrance.

ARTICLE 2: AGE LIMIT

The competitive entrance examination is open to Cameroonians of both sexes and of:

- not more than twenty-nine (29) years old on January 1st 2022 for admission into the first year of the 1st cycle through written examination;
- not more than thirty-two (32) years old on January 1st 2022 for admission into the first year of the 2nd cycle through written examination;
- Candidates who are civil servants and who meet every other requirement are not concerned by the age limit. They must present by the way the authorisation to take the competitive entrance examinations deliver by their administration.



ARTICLE 3: REQUIRED CERTIFICATES

Candidates must be holders of the following certificates:

A. For admission into 1st year of the 1st cycle (written examination)

1. For the Division of Sciences and Technologies of the Tertiary sector

- a) Baccalaureate BT/ESF or General Certificate of Education Advanced Level in Economics, Secretarial Studies, Accounting, Business Studies or Economics and Social issues. Civil servants should be holders of a Baccalaureate and a CAPIET in the speciality.
- b) General Certificate of Education Advanced Level obtained in Economics and in one of the following three papers: Management, History, Geography, in addition to at least four papers at the Ordinary Level (Religious Knowledge excluded).
- c) All other equivalent certificates or qualifications recognised by the Ministry of Higher Education.

2. For admission into the Division of Engineering Sciences and Techniques

- a) Baccalaureate C, D, E, F, BT MAV, BT MB, BT EF, **BREVET PROFESSIONNEL** certificates are not accepted. Civil servants holders of a CAPIET and a baccalaureate in the speciality can apply.
- b) General Certificate of Education Advanced Level obtained in at least two of the following subjects: Pure Mathematics, Applied Mathematics, Further Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, in addition to at least four subjects at the Ordinary level (**Religious Knowledge excluded**).
- c) All other equivalent certificates or qualifications recognised by the Ministry of Higher Education.

B. For admission into 1st year of the 2nd cycle (written examination)

- a) For admission into Administrative Technique (TAD) exclusively: Bachelor Degree in letters, Law or any equivalent certificate recognised by the Minister of Higher Education.
- b) For admission into Guidance Counselling, Department of Education Sciences, exclusively: Bachelor Degree in Law, in Sociology/Psychology, or any equivalent certificate recognised by the Minister of Higher Education.

ARTICLE 4: Candidates preparing for the certificates cited in A, B, C and D above are authorised to take the examinations, subject to obtaining the certificates required. Furthermore, their final admission into ENSET will be confirmed only upon the presentation of the original of the certificate obtained no later than the **07th October 2022**.

ARTICLE 5: APPLICATION FILES

Applications for the competitive entrance examinations which must be received at ENSET and in Regional Delegations of MINESEC not later than the **28th OCTOBER 2022** must include the following documents:

1. An online registration must be done through ENSET Douala website: www.ensetdouala.net, after which the registration form should be printed
2. Transcripts of Lower and Upper Sixth forms, signed, dated and annotated by the Principal of the School where the original were issued.
3. A certified true and legible photocopy of the birth certificate of less than three (3) months old.
4. A certified true and legible photocopy of each of the required certificates

Candidates who are holders of Baccalaureate or GCE AL shall add a certified true copy of Probatoire or Ordinary Level.



As concerns the following certificates: HND delivered by the Ministry of Higher Education, BT, DUT, Bachelor Degree, or equivalent recognised by the Ministry of Higher education, add the transcripts obtained from the Students' Affairs Office of the University Institution concerned, should be added including **certified true and legible** photocopies of the Baccaureate and Probatoire, or the GCE AL and the GCE OL.

5. A medical certificate of less than three (3) months old, delivered by a medical Doctor of the Public Service, attesting the candidate's fitness to be a teacher according to the rules and regulations in force.
6. A certificate of non-conviction of less than three (3) months old.
7. Four (4) passport size pictures of the candidate.
8. A receipt upon payment of the sum of twenty thousand (20,000) FCFA as registration fees. The registration fees are paid into the ENSET bank account n° **51009200001-52** domiciliated at **BICEC**. The fees can be paid into the same account number in all **BICEC** branches nationwide.
9. A stamped, self-addressed envelope size 28 x 37.
10. An unstamped envelope without address size 28 x 37.
11. A document showing **that the equivalence has been formally granted for any foreign certificate** contained in the candidate's file.


ARTICLE 10: The registration fees for the competitive entrance examination and the selection for readmission are not refundable.

ARTICLE 11: PRIVATE CANDIDATES AND FOREIGNERS

- 1) Applicants who fulfil the requirements stipulated by the rules and regulations in force, who are sponsored by a private institution or corporation and who will be trained for private education, may be admitted with a private status and, where applicable, into the 1st year, in accordance with the number or places available.
- 2) Within the limit of available places, foreign applicants who fulfil the requirements stipulated by the rules and regulations in force may also be admitted after the study of their files or through written examination.

ARTICLE 12: The Rector of the University of Douala, the Director of University Accreditations and Quality and the Director of ENSET, each in his/her own sphere, are responsible for the implementation of the present order which shall be registered and published in English and in French wherever necessary.
