The Minister of Higher Education, Chancellor of Academic Orders informs the national and international community that under the Highest Instructions of His Excellency Paul BIYA, President of the Republic, Head of State (Letter n° B1109/b/SG/PRC addressed to the Minster of Higher Education on January 10 2018), the Faculty of Medicine and Biomedical Sciences of Garoua and the Higher Teacher Training College of Betoua shall start in the 2017-2018 academic year. The Head of State has authorised the admission of 85 students in the Faculty of Medicine and Biomedical Sciences of Garoua and 250 student teachers in the Higher Teacher Training College of Bertoua.

In view of operationalising the Directives of the Head of State, the Minister of Higher Education informs would-be candidates that the competitive entrance examinations into the Faculty of Medicine and Biomedical Sciences of Garoua shall take place on January 28 2018 while that of the Higher Teacher Training College shall take place on January 30 2018 for the first cycle and on January 31 2018 for the second cycle.

Practical modalities for these two competitive entrance examinations shall be published in the websites of the Ministry of Higher Education (www.minesup.gov.cm) and of the University of Ngoaundere (www.unregistration.univ-ndere.cm), to which these schools are attached.

The academic year for these schools is scheduled to start in February 2018.
