<u>Article 1</u>: A competition for entry in the 3rd year, License of Technology of the University Institute of Technology of the University of Douala, for the 2018/2019 academic year, is open for **15 September 2018** in the single center of the IUT of Douala.

<u>Article 2</u>: The competition referred to in Article 1 above shall be open to Cameroonians of both sexes and to foreign candidates holding one of the following diplomas or equivalent:

• DUT (University Diploma of Technology)

• BTS (Higher Technician's Certificate)

• Faculty degree with a profile in accordance with the requested option

<u>Article 4</u>: The application must include the following documents:

Registration is online at *www.iut-douala.cm*. The physical file to be deposited in the Department of Education of the University of Douala consists of :

- 1 An application form to be printed after registration online and to stamp at **1000 FCFA**. The **25 000 CFA francs** of the competition fee must be paid before registration on line;
- 2 A certified copy of one of the diplomas giving entitlement to the competition;
- 3 Transcripts corresponding to the two years preparatory to the diploma;
- 4 A certified photocopy of the birth certificate dating from less than 3 months;
- 5 A curriculum vitae;
- 6 A certificate of work (Desirable);
- 7 Two 4x4 identity photos;
- 8 A stamped A4 envelope at 400 FCFA (postage stamp);
- 9 A **simple photocopy** of the National Identity Card;
- 10 A receipt for payment of the sum of twenty five thousand CFA francs (25 000 CFA) of contribution rights to be paid into the account $\bf N$ ° 10033 05214 14004000006 CLE 90 UBA;
- 11 A medical certificate issued by a doctor of the Administration attesting that the candidate is fit to pursue higher education.

Article 5: The complete files will be deposited no later than 10 September 2018, period of rigor, in the Department of Education of the IUT of Douala.

<u>Article 6</u>: The competition consists of a written part depending on the chosen option and a file review.

<u>Article 7</u>: A press release published issued by the Rector of the University of Douala will specify, as necessary, the schedule of the tests.

Article 8: Following the publication of the results, the candidates definitively admitted shall have 15 days from the effective start of the courses to attend the school in order to complete the registration formalities. After this deadline, those who have not presented themselves at the establishment will be considered as having resigned and, if necessary, replaced by the candidates on the waiting list according to the order of merit, by decision of the Minister of Education Superior, on the proposal of the Rector of the University of Douala.

Article 9: The Rector of the University of Douala, the Director of Academic Accreditations and Quality and the Director of the IUT of Douala are each responsible for the implementation of this Order, which will be Recorded and communicated in English and French wherever needed.
