To launch the National Competitive Internship Examination in Cameroon for the 2017–2018 academic year.

THE MINISTER OF HIGHER EDUCATION

Mindful of The Constitution;

Mindful of Law No. 2001/005 of 16 April 2001 on the orientation of Higher Education;

Mindful of Law No. 2007/006 of 26 December 2007 to determine the Financial Regime of the State;

Mindful of Decree No. 2012/433 of 1st October 2012 to organize the Ministry of Higher Education;

Mindful of Decree No. 2013/093 of 3rd April 2013 to organize the Ministry of Public Health;

Mindful of Decree No. 73/796 of 20 December 1973 to reorganize the University Centre for Health Sciences;

Mindful of Decree No. 87/064 of 19 January 1987 to create and reorganize a cycle of specialization in CUSS;

Mindful of Decree No. 92/074 of 13 April 1992 to transform the University Centers of Buea and Ngaoundere into Universities ;

Mindful of Decree No. 93/026 of 19 January 1993 to create Universities;

Mindful of Decree No. 2010/971 of 14 December 2010 to create a State University in Bamenda;

Mindful of Decree No. 93/027 of 19 January 1993 to fix general provisions for Universities as amended and supplemented by decree N°2005/342 of 10 September 2005;

Mindful of Decree No. 2011/408 of 9 December 2011 to organize the Government;

Mindful of Decree No. 2011/410 of 9 December 2011 to appoint members of Government;

Mindful of Decree No. 2001/832/PM of 19 September 2001 to lay down general provisions applicable to Private Institutions of Higher Education;

Mindful of Decree No. 2013/159 of 15 May 2013 to fix a special regime for the administrative control of State finances;

Mindful of Order No. 055/PM of 10 June 2013 on the creation, organisation and functioning of the National Commission for medical, Pharmaceutical and odontostomatologic Training in Cameroon;

Mindful of Press release No. 17/0002/MINESUP/DAUQ of 09 June 2017 issued at the end of the 5th session of the National Commission for Medical, Pharmaceutical and Odonto-stomatological Training in Cameroon.

HEREBY ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Article 1</u>.- (1) A National Competitive Internship Examination in Cameroon is hereby launched for the 2017/2018 academic year.

(2) The papers of the above mentioned examination shall be written in the Faculty of Medicine and Biomedical Sciences of the University of Yaounde I, on **Friday the 13 October 2017**.

<u>Article 2.-</u> Registration for the National Competitive Internship Examination in Medicine shall be open to Cameroonians of both sexes and shall be written in one session.

Article 3.- (1) Eligible candidates for admission shall meet the following criteria:

- Be of Cameroonian nationality;

- To have validated the National Clinical and Therapy Synthesis Certificate (NCTSC) at the end of the twelve semester programme of medical studies;
- To be aged 27 years at most by 1st January of the year of examination.
 - (2) Candidates of the sixth year may apply while waiting for the validation of the National Clinical and Therapy Synthesis Certificate (NCTSC)

Article 4.- (1) Complete application files shall contain the following documents :

- 1. Individual information sheet duly filled by the candidate to be downloaded from the sites www.concours-médecine.uninet.cm and www.minesup.gov.cm. The form bearing an identification number shall be printed by the candidate;
- 2. A Certified true copy of the birth certificate of less than 6 months;
- 3. A certified true copy of the certificates required for the examination;
- 4. An attestation of the presentation of originals signed by competent authorities;
- 5. A medical certificate of physical and mental fitness issued by an authorized medical doctor;

6. 4 colour passport size photographs with the names of the candidate at the back;

- 7. The receipt of payment of the sum of fifty thousand (50,000) CFAF as registration fees for the examination, bearing the field of study, to the address of the Financial Agent of the Department of University Accreditations and Quality (DAUQ), issued from any Express Union branch to Express Union Warda branch, Yaounde;
- 8. Two stamped, self-addressed envelopes.
- (2) Complete application files shall be received latest **Friday the 29 September 2017** at the Faculty of Medicine and Biomedical Sciences (FMSB) University of Yaounde I.
- <u>Article 5.-</u> Only candidates registered online who have submitted their complete application file shall be authorized to write with their National Identity Card.
- Article 6.- The examination shall comprise written papers and oral.
- Article 7.- The examination programme shall be that of level six (6) of medical studies.
- <u>Article 8.-</u> At the end of written papers, the jury appointed by the Minister of Higher Education, shall draw up and publish in alphabetical order the list of successful candidates in the oral examinations.
- Article 9.- The interview shall take place before of a jury made up of at least 4 (four) professors.
- Article 10.- (1) At the end of the interview and considering the marks obtained in other papers, the jury appointed by the Minister of Higher Education, shall draw a list of successful candidates in the competitive examination by order of merit.
- (2) The final results shall be published through a press release by the Minister of Higher Education, according to the quota defined under article 3 of this order.

Article 11.- In any case, there shall be no deferment of admission from one year to another.

<u>Article 12</u>.- Heads of State University Institutions, Heads of Institutions accredited to offer medical trainings and the Director of University Accreditations and Quality of the Ministry of Higher Education shall be responsible, each in his own sphere, for the implementation of this other which shall be registered and published everywhere need arises./-
