

ORDER N° 20-00550 /MINESUP OF 09 JUL 2020

Launching the competitive entrance examination into **Year One, Second Cycle** of the Higher Teacher Training College (ENS) of the University of Ngaoundéré at Bertoua and defining the number of places opened for the **2020/2021** academic year.

**ORDERS AS FOLLOWS**

**Article 1:** A competitive entrance examination into **Year One of the Second Cycle** of the Higher Teacher Training College (ENS) of the University of Ngaoundéré at Bertoua for the **2020/2021** academic year has been launched in the following series:

**Article 2:** (1) The examination is open, in one sitting, to Cameroonians of both sexes who are at most 32 years old on **January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020**, and who fulfil the following conditions:

- **For student teachers of General Secondary Education of all series except the Computer Science, the Earth and Environmental Science, the Guidance Counselling and the Science of Education series,**

Candidates should be holders of a bachelor's degree or "Licence" corresponding to the series opted for or any equivalent diploma recognised by the Ministry of Higher Education.

- **For the Computer Science series**
  - Candidates should be holders of a bachelor's degree in Computer Science, computer engineer or any equivalent diploma recognised by the Ministry of Higher Education for **Fundamental Computer Science**.
  - Candidates should be holders of a bachelor's degree or "Licence" in the Arts and Letters, Banking, Finance, Management, the Humanities, Social Sciences, Law and Political Sciences, Experimental and Pure Sciences, Mathematics or any diploma recognised by the Ministry of Higher Education as being the equivalent of these for the **Information and Communication Technologies option**.
- **For the Guidance Counselling series**
  - Candidates should be holders of a bachelor's degree or "Licence" in Science of Education, Economics, Management, Social Sciences, the Humanities, Law and Political Sciences, experimental and pure sciences or any diploma recognised by the Ministry of Higher Education as being equivalent to these.
- **For the Earth and Environmental Science series**
  - Candidates should be holders of a bachelor's degree in Earth Science, Environmental science or engineer of Mines all specialties, or any equivalent diploma recognised by the Ministry of Higher Education.
- **For all candidates:**
  - Candidates who are civil servants shall not be eligible to write the competitive entrance examination as external candidates.
  - Candidates who are fraudulently admitted without fulfilling the stipulated conditions of basic certificate, grade or age limit, shall be subject to instant dismissal at any moment without any formal procedure.
  - **Professional degrees** issued by the Cameroonian educational and academic system, as well as those issued after professional training, that correspond to the solicited series in ENS Bertoua can sit for the competitive entrance examination.

**Article 3:** The application files shall comprise the following documents:

- **As concerns the section for student-teachers of General Secondary Education and Guidance Counselling,**
  - A registration form available at ENS; at each examination centre; on the website of ENS Bertoua: <https://concours.ensb-univ-ndere.cm>
  - A certified photocopy of the birth certificate which must not be more than three (3) months old from the date of issue;



- Certified true photocopies of transcripts of levels I, II, and III of the “Licence” or bachelor’s degree signed or certified by the competent academic authorities;
- A certified photocopy of the “Licence” or bachelor’s degree or equivalent diploma which must not be more than three (3) months old from the date of issue, or a certified true copy of the results slip signed by the competent academic authority;
- A certificate of non-conviction which must not be more than three (3) months old from the date of issue;

A medical certificate, issued by a medical officer of the Public Administration, testifying that the candidate is physically and medically fit for teaching. It should particularly specify that the candidate does not suffer from serious physiological deficiencies in his diction, hearing, sight and mobility;

A receipt upon payment of twenty thousand (20 0000 FCFA) as registration fees delivered by

**No other form of payment shall be accepted;**

One A4 self-addressed machine-stamped envelope;

Two **coloured, recent** passport-size (4X4) photographs;

An authorisation to sit for the exam issued by the Minister of Basic Education, the Minister of Secondary Education or the Minister of State, Minister of Higher Education for civil servants working in these Ministries.

**Article 4:** Holders of foreign diplomas shall submit either a true copy of the ministerial order granting equivalence or the receipt showing that they have deposited an application for equivalence in the Ministry of Higher Education. These documents must be issued by the Minister of State, Minister of Higher Education. Such candidates can be finally admitted into ENS only if they are granted equivalence for their foreign diplomas or certificates within the limit set by the competent authority.

**Article 5:** All complete files must be deposited with the coordination of the Higher Teacher Training College (ENS) of Bertoua (Direction); or in the Regional Delegations of MINESEC, at the latest on **October 29<sup>th</sup>, 2020.**

**Article 6:** The examination **comprises two parts: written papers and file study.**

- a. Written papers (one major and one minor) count for 70% of the total assessment;
- b. File study counts for 30% of total assessment;
- c. No oral exam.

**Article 7:** (1) The written papers will take place on **November 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020** in the following examination centers: **Bafoussam (IUT-Fotso Victor de Bandjoun), Bamenda (Delegation of Secondary Education Up-Station), Bertoua (ENS Bertoua and Lycée Scientifique), Douala (ESSEC), Ebolowa (ENSET), Garoua (Lycée Classique et Moderne), Maroua (Collège de l’Espoir), Ngaoundéré (Lycée Classique et Moderne) and Yaoundé (ENS Yaoundé and Faculty of Sciences).**

(3) The syllabuses of the competitive entrance examination are the same as those of the "Baccalaureat" /GCE A/L + 3 years of Faculties and higher education institutions of State universities.

(4) The grading of each written paper ranges from zero to twenty and is multiplied by the aforementioned coefficients. Any score below five on twenty (5/20) is eliminatory.

**Article 8:** The assessment of candidates' files will be based on:

- the relevance of the candidate's academic profile;
- the candidate's age;
- the number of years spent in the University to obtain the "Licence" or bachelor's degree;
- marks scored in subjects of the candidate's area of specialisation in levels I, II and III of the Licence or bachelor's degree and, eventually, the candidate's grades.

**Article 9:** After the written paper, the jury shall prepare the list of successful candidates per series and by order of merit. The final results will be published by the Minister of State, the Minister of Higher Education. Successful candidates cannot, under any circumstance, postpone their registration to the following academic year.

**Article 10:** The make-up of the jury mentioned in articles 9-12 above shall be specified by the Minister of State, the Minister of State, Minister of Higher Education in conformity with the current rules and regulations.

**Article 11:** The registration fees mentioned in article 3 are non-refundable.

**Article 12:** The Rector of the University of Ngaoundéré, the Director of the Department of University Accreditations and Quality, and the Coordination of the Higher Teacher Training College of Bertoua are responsible, each in his/her own capacity, for the implementation of this circular which shall be registered and published in English and French wherever need be.
