Launching competitive examination in the **first year** and direct admission in the **second year** of the **alternate cycles** into the National Advanced School of Posts, Telecommunications and Information and Communication Technologies (SUP'PTIC) of Yaoundé, for the **2020-2021** academic year.

- Mindful** of decree N°092/050 of 24th March 1992 instituting the statute of National advanced School of Posts and Telecommunications;
- Mindful** of decree N°2011/408 of 09th December 2011 organising the Government;
- Mindful** of decree N°2011/410 of 09th December 2011 appointing the members of government;
- Mindful** of decree N°2012/512 of 12th April 2012 organising the Ministry of Posts and Telecommunications;
- Mindful** of decree N°2012/433 of 1st April 2012 organising the Ministry of Higher Education;
- Mindful** of decree N° 2016/425 of 26th October 2016 changing the denomination and reorganizing the National Advanced School of Posts and Telecommunications;
- Mindful** of decree n°2017/594 of 04th December 2017 appointing the Director and the deputy Director of the National advanced School of the Posts, Telecommunications and Information and Communication Technologies;
- Mindful** of decree N°2019/002 of 04th January 2019 to reshuffle the Government;
- Mindful** of order N° 20-00407/MINESUP/SG/DAUQ/SDEAC/SE of 26th may 2020, to modify order N° 20-00106/MINESUP/SG/DAUQ/SDEAC/SE of 17th march 2020, organizing the calendar of competitive entrance examinations into Faculties, Schools and institutions of Cameroon State Universities for 2020-2021 academic year;

On the proposal of the Director of the National Advanced School of Posts, Telecommunications and Information and Communication Technologies.

DECIDE:

ARTICLE 1: Competitive entrance examinations for admission into the **Alternate cycles** of **Inspectors of Posts and Telecommunications** and **Assistant Telecommunications Engineers** cycles of the National Advanced School of Posts, Telecommunications and Information and Communication shall be written on the **08th and 09th of October 2020** at the unique centre Yaoundé.

ARTICLE 2: GENERAL CONDITIONS FOR WRITING

- 1- **Assistant Telecommunications Engineers (ATE) / Bachelor in Engineering**
 - Should be male or female, aged 15 years at least as from the 1st January 2020;
 - Should be a holder of the General Certificate of Education "Advanced Level" certificate in at least three science subjects, further mathematics and Physics, A' level technical GCE or any equivalent certificate in above specialities.
- 2- **Inspectors of Posts and Telecommunications (IPT) / Bachelor in Administration**
 - Should be male or female, aged 15 years at least as from the 1st January 2020;
 - Should be a holder of the General Certificate of Education "Advanced Level" in at least two subjects or any recognised equivalent certificate.

ARTICLE 3: NUMBER OF PLACES AVAILABLE

The number of places available per cycle is as follow:

ARTICLE 4: CONTENT OF CANDIDATE'S FILE

Candidate's file which must be submitted at the National Advanced School of Posts, Telecommunications and Information and Communication Technologies (SUP'PTIC) of Yaounde, on the **06th October 2020 for the Cameroonian candidates and 31st October 2020 for the foreign candidates** latest, shall be made up of the following documents:

- An application form duly filled by the candidate on line on the web site of the National Advanced School of Posts, Telecommunications and Information and Communication Technologies of Yaounde (**www.supptic-cmr.cm**);
- A payment receipt of **20,000 CFA** to any Post office, account number **150657330-19**;
- A certified true copy of birth certificate not more than 03 Months old from the date of certification;
- A certified true copy of the required certificate;
- A school attendance certificate for candidates still expecting the results of the required certificate;
- A medical certificate of fitness for working in the Posts and telecommunications sector, issued by a public medical practitioner;
- Four passport size photographs (4x4);
- A certified true copy of the National Identity card;
- A self-addressed stamped envelope (**500 FCFA** Postal Stamp)
- A certificate of effective presence for civil servant candidates.

ARTICLE 8: Candidate are requested to come to the examination centres at least **30 minutes** before the start of each examination paper. They must come along with their national identity card.

ARTICLE 9: Admission in the second year of the cycle for Assistant Telecommunications Engineers and for Inspectors is granted for candidates' holders of:

- **For the Assistant Telecommunications Engineers**, Diploma of Telecommunications Technician of SUP'PTIC, DEUG, BTS, DSEP, DUT, HND or HDD in Telecommunications, Electronics, Electrotechnics and Computer sciences or any recognised equivalent certificate;
- **For the Posts and Telecommunications Inspectors**, Diploma of Posts and Telecommunication Controllers of SUP'PTIC, HND, DEUG in Economics, Management, Law sciences or any recognised equivalent certificate.

ARTICLE 10: SCHOOL FEES PER YEAR

Candidates admitted into the school shall pay the following on the yearly basis.

 - * Assistant Telecommunications Engineers **800.000 F CFA**
 - * Inspectors of Posts and Telecommunications **800.000 F CFA**

ARTICLE 11: Examination registration fees are non-refundable.

ARTICLE 12: Only candidates who have submitted a complete and regular file shall be authorised to sit for the examinations.

ARTICLE 13: The results of the examinations shall be published by a communiqué of the Minister of Higher Education and the Minister of Posts and Telecommunications.


ARTICLE 14: Foreign students shall sit for special examinations organised by the Director of the National Advanced School of Posts, Telecommunications and Information and Communication Technologies in collaboration with the countries concerned.

ARTICLE 15: Candidates presented by the public and para-statal organisms fulfilling the general conditions for the competitive entrance examination shall be authorised to write the exams.

ARTICLE 16: At the end of their training, the best students will be admitted directly in the master program.

ARTICLE 17: The Director of the National Advanced School of Posts, Telecommunications and Information and Communication Technologies and the Director for University Accreditations and Quality are each in his capacity, responsible for the implementation of this decision, which shall be registered, published and broadcast wherever need be./-
