To launch the competitive examination for admission into the **Third Year (Bachelor of Technology)** at the University Institute of Technology (UIT) of the University of Douala and to decide on the number of places available, for the 2021/2022 academic year.

ANNOUNCES:

Article 1: A competitive entrance examination for the admission into the Third year of Technology Bachelor of the University Institute of Technology of the University of Douala, for the 2021/2022 academic year, shall take place on **7th September 2021**, at the single center of the IUT of Douala.

Article 2: The competitive entrance examination referred to, in article 1 above, is opened to Cameroonians of both sexes and to foreign candidates holding one of the following diplomas or its equivalent:

- UDT (University Diploma of Technology)
- HND (Higher National Diploma)
- Faculty Bachelor with profile in accordance with the requested option.

Article 3: The number of available places for this entrance is equal to **one thousand seven hundred and eighty five (1785)** standing as follows:

Article 4: The complete application file must comprise the following documents:

- 1- A registration form to be duly **completed online** in the Web site of UIT of Douala: www.iut-douala.cm, printed and signed by the candidate, and stamped at CFAF 1,000 FCFA. An amount of **CFAF 25,000** of examination fees must be paid before registering online;
- 2- A certified true copy of the required diploma ;
- 3- The transcripts corresponding to the two years preparatory to the diploma;
- 4- A certified true **photocopy** of the birth certificate issued within the last three (03) months ;
- 5- A curriculum vitae;
- 6- A labour certificate (Desirable);
- 7- Two (02) recent passport-size photographs of the candidate;
- 8- A 21 x 29.7 size self-addressed envelope bearing a CFAF 400 postal stamp;
- 9- A simple photocopy of the National Identity Card;
- 10- A **twenty five thousand (25 000)** CFA francs banking receipt representing the examination fees to be paid at the **UBA account N° 10033 05214 14004000006 – 90**, or at the **BICEC account N° 01253101002-18**
- 11- A medical certificate issued within the last three (03) months by a state medical practitioner and testifying that the candidate is fit for higher education ;

Article 5: The complete files must be submitted on **3rd September 2021** latest in the Admissions Office of the Douala University Institute of Technology.



Article 6 : The examination has a written paper which depends on the option.

Article 7: A press release from the Rector of the University of Douala will specify as necessary the planning of the various papers.

Article 8: Successful candidates shall report to UIT for registration formalities within **fifteen days** following the date of publication of the final results. Candidates, who fail to comply with this requirement, as need arise, shall be replaced by those on the waiting list following the order of merit, through a press release published by the Minister of Higher Education on the recommendation of the Rector of the University of Douala.

Article 9: The Rector of the University of Douala, the Director of University Accreditations and Quality, and the Director of UIT of Douala, each in his own sphere, are responsible for the implementation of the present press release which shall be registered and published in English and in French wherever necessary./-
