To launch the competitive entrance examination into the 3rd year of the **Engineering Course**, at the National Higher Polytechnic School of Douala (NHPSD) of the University of Douala, Agenla Academy of Yaoundé (AA), l'Institut Supérieur de Technologie et d'Etudes Commerciales of Bangangté (ISTEC), l'Institut Supérieur de Management et de l'Entrepreneuriat in Douala (IME), l'Institut Universitaire des Grandes Ecoles des Tropiques of Douala (IUGET), Jacquy Felly Nanfack (JFN-HUI) of Douala, l'Ecole Supérieure d'Ingénieurs et de Management d'Afrique Centrale (ESIAC) of Douala and l'Institut Universitaire Bilingue du Littoral (INUBIL) of Douala and to specify the number of places available for the academic year 2024/2025.

- Mindful of Decision n°18240028/MINESUP/SG/DAUQ/SDEAC of 14 February 2024 to organize the calendar of competitive entrance examinations into Faculties, Schools and institutions of Cameroon state Universities for 2024/2025 academic year.

DECIDES:

Article 1: (1)The public is hereby informed that a competitive entrance examination for the admission of **one thousand three hundred and sixty (1360) students** into the **third year of engineering course** at the National Higher Polytechnic School of Douala (NHPSD) of the University of Douala Agenla Academy of Yaoundé (AA), l'Institut Supérieur de Technologie et d'Etudes Commerciales of Bangangté (ISTEC), l'Institut Supérieur de Management et de l'Entrepreneuriat à Douala (IME), l'Institut Universitaire des Grandes Ecoles des Tropiques of Douala (IUGET), Jacquy Felly Nanfack (JFN-HUI) of Douala, l'Ecole Supérieure d'Ingénieurs et de Management d'Afrique Centrale (ESIAC) of Douala and l'Institut Universitaire Bilingue du Littoral (INUBIL) of Douala has been launched for the 2024/2025 academic year, in the centers of **BANDJOUN, BERTOUA, EBOLOWA, DOUALA, GAROUA, MAROUA, NGAOUNDERE and YAOUNDE**. Article 2: The competitive entrance is open to:

- Candidates who are holders of Scientific Degree; an Engineer Diploma of works; Degree in Technology, **Professional Bachelor Degree in the speciality, an HND in the speciality**, a scientific university diploma in technology (DUT), a scientific university diploma of general studies (DEUG) and All equivalent diploma recognized by the Ministry of Higher Education.
- Candidates awaiting results in 2024/2025 for the certificates mentioned above.

Article 3: (1) The syllabus for the examinations shall be that of the classes leading to the qualifying certificate or diploma.

(2) The written examination consists of a written paper depending on the candidate's speciality and shall last for three hours.

(3) There will be no oral exams.

Article 4: Candidate's files shall include the following documents:

- 1- An individual registration form to be completed online at www.enspd-ud.cm. The completed form shall be printed accompanied by a 1 500 francs fiscal stamp and be signed by the candidate; Registration is done online at: www.enspd-udo.cm
- 2- A certified true photocopy of birth certificate not older than three months;
- 3- A certified true photocopy of required certificate;
- 4- Certified true photocopies of level one, two and three transcripts;
- 5- A certified true photocopy of "probatoire" or GCE O/L and GCE A/L or "baccalauréat" certificate or slip as the case may be;
- 6- A medical certificate not older than three (3) months issued by a state medical practitioner testifying that the candidate is fit for higher education; *Bye*

- 7- An A4 format self-addressed envelope bearing a 1000 francs CFA postal stamp with candidate's address on it.

Article 5: The registration fees for the entrance examination is **Twenty-Five Thousand (25 000) Francs CFA** payable at the **UBA bank Account n° 0 100 500 000 287** of the University of Douala or through the services of **Express Union to the same account in towns where UBA is not present;** against a bank receipt which is obligatory to be included in candidate's file. **The registration fee is not reimbursable.** It is destined to cover charges generated as the result of the organisation of the entrance examination. **Any other means of payment is unacceptable.**


Article 6: - All complete application files must be deposited at the admissions office of the National Higher Polytechnic School of Douala (NHPSD) of the University of Douala or at the Regional Delegations of the Ministry of Secondary Education no latest than **Thursday 25th July 2024 at 3:30 pm.**


Article 7: Only candidates who have submitted complete application files will be authorised to sit for the examination. They are therefore requested to come along with their National Identity Card and the examination registration receipt (to be downloaded) which must be presented to the authorities before entering the examination hall.

Article 8: The candidates for the competitive entrance examination into the third year must not be older than **thirty-two (32) years** on the January 1st 2024.

Article 9: The written examination will take place on **Sunday 28th July 2024, at 8 am** in the centers indicated above.

Article 10: The Rector of the University of Douala, the Director of the Department of University Accreditations and Quality and the Director of the National Higher Polytechnic School (ENSPD) of the University of Douala are each in their capacity, responsible for the implementation of this decision which shall be registered and published in English and French wherever need arises.
