To Launch the Competitive Entrance Examination into the **Third Year** of Studies at the **National Higher Polytechnic Institute (NAHPI)** of **The University of Bamenda** and to Fix the Number of Places Available for the **2024/2025 Academic Year**.

Mindful of Decision N° 18240028/MINESUP/SG/DAUQ/SDEAC of 14 February, 2024 to fix the calendar of Entrance Examinations for Cameroonian State Universities and Schools under the academic supervision of MINESUP, for the academic year 2024/2025.

HEREBY DECIDES AS FOLLOWS:

Article 1: A competitive entrance examination by study of files is hereby launched for entry of **100 students** into the **Third Year** of studies for the award of the Professional Master of Engineering (M.Eng; classified as GCE A/L+5) of the National Higher Polytechnic Institute of The University of Bamenda, for the 2024/2025 academic year in the following departments and programmes:

Article 2: All successful applicants entering into the **third year** of this Institute will be required to pay training fees fixed by the Council of the University of Bamenda, in addition to University registration fees, per annum, until completion of studies at the M.Eng level. For details, please visit the website of the Institute at www.nahpi.cm.

Article 3: The competitive entrance examination is opened to Cameroonians and foreigners (*foreigners pay higher fees unless regulated otherwise; please visit www.nahpi.cm to learn more*) of both sexes. Applicants must hold one of the following qualifications in a relevant discipline: **HND** or **UDT** or **BTS** or **Bachelor** or **DIPET I or II** (with permission to study for civil servants) or any other qualification recognized as equivalent by the Cameroon Ministry of Higher Education. All applicants must have also good grades in O/L and/or A/L Mathematics.

Article 4: Few remedial courses could be prescribed to admit students, as necessary;

Article 5: The application file shall comprise the following documents:

- A receipt (original copy) upon payment of **twenty thousand (20,000) FCFA** as non-refundable entrance registration fees into the account of NAHPI delivered by UBA Bank using the following bank code **10033**, branch code **05204**, and account number **0400400009038**. **NB: No other form of payment is acceptable; Payment of the entrance registration fee is a pre-requisite for the online registration.**
- The submission confirmation page of a registration form duly filled and submitted by the candidate **online**, at the NAHPI website www.nahpi.cm after payment of the entrance examination fees mentioned above. The submission confirmation page or Acceptance Slip should be printed and a copy of it submitted with the other documents listed below:
 - A certified true copy of birth certificate dated not more than three (03) months;
 - A medical certificate of fitness issued by a State Medical Practitioner dated not more than three (03) months;
 - A certified true copy of entry certificate or attestation of success where applicable;

- A certified true copy of either GCE A/L or Baccalaureate certificate or GCE Technical A/L or Baccalaureate Technical Industrial certificate, as the case may be;
- Certified true copies of Transcripts for the last years of study in the University or a Higher Institution which issued the Certificate or Attestation of success;
- A Curriculum Vitae;
- Four passport-size photographs;
- One self-addressed large envelope bearing a **400 francs CFA** postal stamp;


Article 6: The complete application file should be submitted at the Office of the Director of the National Higher Polytechnic Institute in **Bambili** or at the Regional Delegation of Secondary Education in **Bamenda, Bafoussam, Buea, Douala or Yaounde, only, on or before Friday, 6th September 2024**. Late or incomplete application files shall be rejected.

Article 7: The assessment of the competitive entrance examination shall be by study of files and will take into consideration the following;

- a) Grades of the entry diplomas and degree: 70/100;
- b) Relevance of entry diploma or degree: 10/100;
- c) Age of the candidate: 10/100;
- d) Duration of studies to obtain entry diploma or degree: 10/100

Article 8: A jury designated by the competent authority shall prepare the list of successful candidates per programme by order of merit and submit it, in strict compliance, to the Minister of State, Minister of Higher Education for publication.

Article 10: The Vice Chancellor of The University of Bamenda, the Director of University Accreditations and Quality and the Director of the National Higher Polytechnic Institute are each in his/her own sphere responsible for the implementation of this Decision, which shall be registered and published in English and French wherever necessary.
