To launch a competitive entrance examination into the **third year** of the Biomedical and Health Science Programmes in the Faculty of Sciences of the University of Ngaoundere, for the 2024/2025 academic year.

HEREBY DECIDES AS FOLLOWS:

Article 1: A files study competition is currently underway at the Department of Biomedical Sciences of the Faculty of Sciences (FS) of the University of Ngaoundéré for the academic year 2024/2025. The competition is intended to recruit **one hundred and ten (110) third-year students** in the Medical Imaging and Radiology, Biomedical sciences, one health and Nursing programs.

Article 2: The competition is open in a single session to holders of the following diplomas: **Bachelor in Science**, BAC+2 in health (MINESUP), **Technicien Médico-Sanitaire**, **Technicien de Radiologie Médicale**, **Infirmier Diplômé d'Etat**, **BTS/HND**, or any other equivalent certificate recognized by the Minister of Higher Education.

Article 3: (1) Applicants selected into the competition must contribute to training fees, the amount of which is determined by a specific text;

(2) Members of the Central African Economic and Monetary Community (CEMAC) who have ratified the text concerning the national treatment of students will also be admitted under the same conditions like those of Cameroonians.

Article 4: A candidate's complete application file will be deposited at the Admission and Records Office of the Faculty of Science, University of Ngaoundere or at the antennae of University of Ngaoundere-Yaounde (Nkolbison), at Admission and Records Office of the Faculty of Science, University of Maroua, not later than **15th November 2024** and, shall comprise the following documents:

1. An application form, available on the MINESUP website: www.minesup.gov.cm, the Admission and Records Office of the Faculty of Science, University of Ngaoundere, at the Admission and Records Office of the Faculty of Science, University Maroua, or at the faculty of Science web site fs.univ-ndere.cm);
2. Certified copy of National Identity Card
3. Certified copy of birth certificate not more than 03 months old;
4. An official copy of the diplomas that grant entry to the competition or, if applicable, an achievement certificate for this diploma signed by an appropriate administrative authority;
5. Certified copies matching the first, second, and/or third year's worth of signed receipts from the acquisition establishment;
6. Certified true photocopies of GCE/OL or GCE/AL certificate or any certified proof of success to one of these examinations;

7. A certified true photocopy of birth certificate A medical certificate of physical and mental fitness, testifying that the candidate is apt for higher education studies, issued by a medical doctor of the public administration;
8. A receipt issued upon payment of **20.000 frs CFA** as registration fee issued by **CCA-Bank (account : 10039-10013-02373355702-86)** Ngaoundéré
9. A self-addressed A4 envelop, stamped appropriately.
10. Two passport-size photographs 4x4, with the names of the candidate at the back;
NB: Candidates who have submitted their application, subject to the Bachelor will only be admitted to the competition after presentation of proof of their admission to the above diploma (signed pass slip, transcript, etc.).

Article 5 : Candidates with foreign degrees must provide either an official certificate of equivalency or the receipt for deposit of the equivalency request issued by the Minister of State or the Minister of Higher Education. However, their final admission, the awarding of their degree, and/or proof of their success upon completion of their studies can only be obtained upon presentation within the timeframes set by the relevant authority, a document attesting to the degree's equivalent, and a document obtained by the Candidate's care at the Ministry of Higher Education.

Article 6 : The competition has a 100% academic note. This note is established based on the following considerations:

- The candidate's age;
- The number of years they spent obtaining the required degree;
- - Academic results at levels I and II.

Article 7 : The number of available places is distributed as follows:

Article 8: (1) The deliberations are carried out by a jury appointed by the Minister of Higher Education following the proposition of the Rector of the University of Ngaoundere.

(2) The final results are published through a press release by the Minister of Higher Education.

Article 9: The Rector of the University of Ngaoundere, the Director of University Accreditations and Quality and the Dean of the Faculty of Sciences of the University of Ngaoundere are responsible, each in his sphere of competence, for the implementation of this Decision which will be registered and published wherever necessary/.
