



DECISION N° 18260525 /MINESUP/SG/DAUQ/SDEAC OF 12 AOUT 2026
TO LAUNCH THE COMPETITIVE ENTRANCE EXAMINATIONS INTO THE FIRST YEAR OF THE FIELD OF STUDY
MINING ENGINEERING, AT THE NATIONAL ADVANCED SCHOOL OF ENGINEERING OF YAOUNDE (NASEY),
MEYOMESSALA SITE AND TO SPECIFY THE NUMBER OF PLACES AVAILABLE FOR THE 2026/2027 ACADEMIC
YEAR.

Mindful of Order N20-00006 /MINESUP/SG/DAUQ of 01st July 2020 to modify and complete Order N°18005011/MINESUP/SG/DAUQ of 28 June 2018 to create fields of "Digital Arts" and "Digital Humanities" at the National Advanced School of Engineering of University of Yaounde I;
Mindful of decision No18260039/MINESUP/SG/DAUQ/SDEAC of 17th February 2026, to organize the calendar of competitive entrance examinations into Faculties, Schools and Institutes of Cameroon State Universities for 2026-2027 academic year.

DECIDES AS FOLLOWS:

Article 1: (1) A competitive entrance examination for the admission of **one hundred and fifty (150)** students into the first year of **Engineering Mining Programme**, at the National Advanced School of Engineering of Yaounde (NASEY), has been launched for the **2026/2027** academic year.
These competitive entrance examinations will take place in the following centres: **Bafoussam, Bamenda, Bertoua, Buca, Douala, Ebolowa, Garoua, Maroua, Ngaoundere and Yaounde.**

Article 2: The competitive entrance examination is open to:

- Final year students of the Baccalaureate and candidates preparing for the General Certificate of Education Advanced Level (GCE-A/L) provided that they have passed in at least four subjects (Religious Knowledge excluded) at the GCE-O/L in one sitting;
- Holders of the Baccalaureate or at least two GCE-A/L papers excluding Religious Knowledge, obtained in one sitting, or any other equivalent certificates recognised by the Ministry of Higher Education.

Article 3: (1) The syllabus of the examinations is made up of the common areas of the programmes of the Lower and Upper Sixth classes or the *Premières* and *Terminales* classes of the French Sub-system.

(2) Foreign candidates from the CEMAC zone who have ratified the texts related to the national treatment of students and meet the same academic requirements can be admitted to compete under the same academic conditions as their Cameroonian counterparts, and, within the limits of available spots, according to the regulations in force.

(3) Foreign candidates from countries that are not members of CEMAC contribute to the training fees, the amount of which is set by a specific regulation.

(4) There will be no oral examination.

Article 4: If successful in the competitive entrance examination, candidates awaiting the results of the above-mentioned certificate examinations shall be admitted into the NASEY only on presentation of an Attestation of success or the original results slip of the certificate obtained in 2025, within the deadline set by the NASEY.

Article 5: Registration for the entrance examination is done online on the NASEY website:

The application file shall include the following documents:

1. An individual record form duly filled by the candidate on the entrance examination page of the School's website: <http://www.polytechnique.cm/concours>;
2. A photocopy of the National Identity Card or its receipt, or the school identity card;
3. A certified true copy of the birth certificate (not more than three months old);
4. A certified true copy of the Baccalaureate or GCE-A/L in two subjects (Religious Knowledge excluded) or equivalent certificate recognised by the Ministry of Higher Education or an Attestation of success of any of the above;
5. Transcripts of the *Probatoire* and Baccalaureate or Form five (GCE-O/L class) and Upper Sixth (GCE-A/L class) whichever is applicable;
6. 4 passport size photos (4 x 4);
7. A medical attestation of physical fitness delivered by a State registered medical doctor;
8. A self-addressed A4-size stamped (1 500 francs CFA) envelope.

Article 6: The examination fee of **twenty thousand (20 000) francs CFA** shall be payable only through **EXPRESS UNION** with a receipt delivered in exchange. The receipt shall be attached to the candidate's application file. The examination fee which is non-refundable shall be used in covering expenses related to the organization of the examinations. **Any other means of payment shall not be accepted.**

Article 7: The complete application file shall reach either the Admissions Office of The National Advanced School of Engineering of Yaounde, P.O. 8390 Yaounde, or the Regional Delegation of the Ministry of Secondary Education of the candidate's place of residence **latest the 11 of September 2026.**

Article 8: Only candidates who have submitted complete application files within the deadline will be called upon to write the exams. They are therefore requested to come along with **their National Identity Cards** or **their school identity cards** which must be presented to the examination authorities.

Article 9: Candidates for the entrance examination into the first year must **not be above 29 years of age** by the 1st of January 2026.

Article 10: (1) The written examinations will be held on the **18 of September 2026**, in the centres indicated above.

(2) Candidates registered for the examinations with a complete file and having at least a score of "Excellent" in the Baccalaureate in the 2026 session or five (05) papers with grade "A" at the GCE-A/L obtained in the 2026 session, can benefit from a direct admission.

(3) At the end of the deliberations of the jury setup by the Minister of State, Minister of Higher Education, a list of candidates proposed for final admission in order of merit, which will be published by the Minister of State, Minister of Higher Education shall be drawn up.

Article 11: The Rector of the University of Yaounde I, the Director of the Department of University Accreditations and Quality, and the Director of the National Advanced School of Engineering of Yaounde, each in his own sphere, are responsible for the implementation of this Press Release which shall be registered and published in English and French, wherever necessary.
