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**120th AND 121th ORDINARY SESSIONS OF THE NATIONAL COMMISSION
FOR THE EVALUATION OF TRAINING DOMAINS OFFERED ABROAD**

FINAL COMMUNIQUE

Under the High Supervision of the Minister of State, Minister of Higher Education, Chancellor of Academic Orders, the 120th and 121th Ordinary Sessions of the National Commission for the Evaluation of Training Domains Offered Abroad took place on Wednesday, 9th september 2026, in the conference room of the Higher Teacher Training College of the University of Yaounde I.

Prof. Wilfrid NYONGBET GABSA, Secretary General of the Ministry of Higher Education, chaired the Session on behalf of the Minister of State, Minister of Higher education. The Representative of the Minister of Public Service and Administrative Reform, in his capacity as Vice-chairman, the Representatives of the Prime Minister's Office, as well as statutory members, guests and experts of the said Commission were all in attendance. The Technical Secretariat was composed of personnel of the Sub Department of equivalence of the Department for the Coordination of Academic Activities of the Ministry of Higher Education.

After the usual greetings, singing of the National Anthem and the verification of the quorum, three main points structured the meeting, namely:

- 1- the opening speech by the Secretary General of the Ministry of Higher Education;
- 2- word of the framework of the Session by the Director for the Coordination of Academic Activities of the Ministry of Higher Education;
- 3- the examination of the files of requests for equivalence of foreign certificates, titles and university degrees.

The fruitful discussions, exchanges and contributions resulted in the following main deliberations:

For the 120th Ordinary Session

- **1206** requests for equivalences ;
- **778** equivalences granted, representing a rate of **89,55%** ;
- **45** files rejected and **69** requests pending.

For the 121th Ordinary Session

- **1013** requests for equivalences ;
- **1080** equivalences granted, representing a rate of **76,8%**;
- **21** files rejected and **214** requests pending.

In total, out of **2,219** requests for equivalences, **1,858** equivalences were **granted**, representing a rate of **83.73%**. Regarding online applications specifically, since January 1, 2025, the launch date of this new system, we have recorded a total of **3,550** equivalences requested for **2,804** granted equivalences, representing a rate of **78.98%**.

It is worth noting here that, via the website www.equivalence.cm, users can now access the following remote services:

- 1- online request for equivalence, with the ability to download the submission receipt;**
- 2-online tracking of the application with full transparency and objectivity;**
- 3-upon publication of the results and in the event of a favorable decision, the digital equivalence certificate featuring a QR code becomes automatically available for download from the user's personal online account.**

The National Commission expresses its sincere thanks to the **Government of the Republic** for the human, material and financial resources made available for the diligent and efficient accomplishment of its missions, which are in line with the **New University Governance Policy**, prescribe by **His Excellency Paul BIYA, PRESIDENT OF THE REPUBLIC, HEAD OF STATE**, and implemented under the clear-sighted coordination of the **Prime Minister, Head of Government**, around the trinomial Quality-Assurance, Professionalization and Digitalization of Education, Employability of Graduates. /- ✓
